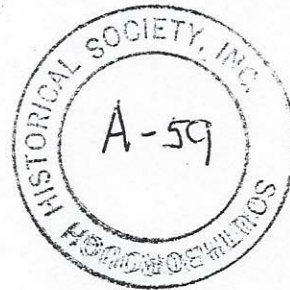


A list, in numerical order, of the gravestones in the
