- Please only submit written or photographic material which you own or have created
- You must be 18 years of age or older to submit content. If you are under 18, please ask a parent or guardian to submit content on your behalf.

By submitting materials to Southborough Historical Society

- I represent that I am the sole owner of the uploaded materials and that I have full right and authority to donate these materials to by the Southborough Historical Society (SHS). I understand that the location, retention and preservation of the materials, and other considerations relating to their use or disposition, will be made in accordance with SHS policies and the material may be made available for research on an unrestricted basis. I understand that the donations I am making are permanent donations.
